Our next campout is to the Wright-Patterson AFB in Dayton, Ohio. We will leave Holy Trinity at 7:00 am (6:40am arrival at the church) on Saturday, April 6, and drive to Wapakoneta, OH, to tour the Neil Armstrong Air and Space Museum. We will then drive to West Liberty, OH, to have lunch and explore the Ohio Caverns. If time permits, we head to Urbana College to view the largest collection of exhibits available on the history of John Chapman (a.k.a. Johnny Appleseed). We will set up camp for the night at nearby Dayton KOA. On Sunday morning we break camp and travel to the IMAX Theatre in Dayton to see one of their 3D movies, after that we will eat lunch and then enter the National Museum of the US Air Force located on Wright Patterson Air Force Base (10 acres of Indoor exhibits including 400 aircraft, missiles, and much more). We will head home in the late-afternoon. Trip Cost is **\$40 per scout or adult**, (min.20 folks to make the trip a go!) Permission slip/money can be turned in any time before April 1st, so we may make the necessary reservations.
